HONG KONG Maritime Week

When the curtain came down on Hong Kong Maritime Week (HKMW) 2023, the Hong Kong Maritime and Port Board (HKMPB), its co-organisers, and the arrangers of around 50 activities successfully showcased the very best of Hong Kong's maritime industry — its strength, vision, resilience, and innovation.



Chief Executive of the Hong Kong SAR, Mr John Lee set the tone for the Week in his address at the Opening Ceremony:

“From the disruptions of global supply chains, to the change in the spending pattern of customers, the world of maritime needs a solution to give the industry a boost. A recharge. Hong Kong is glad and eager to contribute.”

Highlighting the synergy of the Opening Ceremony with the 3rd World Maritime Merchants Forum, Mr Lee added: “The convergence of these two influential maritime events signifies Hong Kong's unique role, as a "super-connector", as well as a "super value-adder" in the global and regional maritime industry, where we can capitalise on new opportunities together to ensure a prosperous future for the shipping industry.”



In his address to the Opening Ceremony, the Chairman of the HKMPB and Secretary for Transport and Logistics Mr Lam Sai-hung highlighted the growing status of HKMW:

“This year, we are also joining hands with 12 support organisations, including three new partners, who collectively represent

some of the most prominent organisations at the forefront of the maritime industry. These developments reflect our overall drive to scale up the Hong Kong Maritime Week and enhance Hong Kong as the premier destination for international dialogue, exchange, and co-operation.”

Mr Lam summed up Hong Kong’s can-do attitude to industry challenges by echoing the old saying: “We cannot direct the wind, but we can adjust our sails.”

He also left visitors much to look forward to when he announced the imminent publication of an “Action Plan” to set out a comprehensive strategy for the maritime and port development in Hong Kong.

HKMW 2023 wrap up

From industry leaders to local businesses and government departments, all organisers were happy to report strong attendance and an enthusiastic reception.

Apart from the flagship events of the 3rd World Maritime Merchants Forum and Asian Logistics, Maritime and Aviation Conference, public programmes of various themes, such as the HKMW Orienteering Race, Hong Kong Sea School Open Day, guided tour to Harbour Patrol Section and more, continues to attract an enthusiastic response from the public, especially on aspiring young people.

The Hong Kong Government’s promotion of its tax concessions scheme for shipping commercial principals received a vigorous boost when the topic was discussed across different key events.
